Several large trees were snapped or uprooted in downtown Galesburg and in the Standish Park area. An industrial building lost part of its roof and a transformer pole was snapped when a large tree fell across a road. A large portion of Galesburg was without power due to the storm.

**A cold front triggered scattered strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of west-central Illinois during the early morning of September 8th. One of the cells produced wind damage in Galesburg in Knox County, while other storms dropped as much as 3 to 5 inches of rain across parts of Knox, Fulton, and Cass counties.**
