

Timing, Snowfall, Impacts, Confidence

Thu Night – Fri Night



Timing:

- Precipitation moves south to north across central Kentucky Thursday Evening/Night, ending early Saturday morning
 - Most significant icing late Thursday Night
 - Most significant snow Friday

Precip:

- Snow expected over south-central Indiana and north-central Kentucky
- Freezing rain and/or sleet over central/south-central Kentucky Thursday night changes to snow Friday
- Snow could be heavy at times over portions of central Kentucky Friday

Impacts:

- Very hazardous road conditions likely Thursday night through Friday night
- Power outages likely in heaviest ice and snow regions

Confidence:

- High confidence in winter storm occurrence Thursday night through Friday night
- Increasing confidence of significant snow/ice accumulations over parts of central KY
