- This will create hazardous and treacherous roads





Updated and Final Totals Expected By Saturday




WINTER STORM WARNING TIMING

Winter Storm

Timing, Snowfall, Impacts, Confidence Today– Saturday Morning



Timing:

- Most of the precip ending or done along/west of I-65
- Light snow continues overnight east of I-65, including Bluegrass region and Lexington metro

Precip:

- Light additional accumulations possible across east-central KY including Richmond, Lexington areas

Impacts:

- KY State of Emergency Declared...Travel Not Recommended Except for Emergency Personnel.
- Indiana...Very hazardous road conditions likely through Saturday morning.
- Southern Indiana and State of Kentucky – Strong winds creating blowing and drifting snow!
