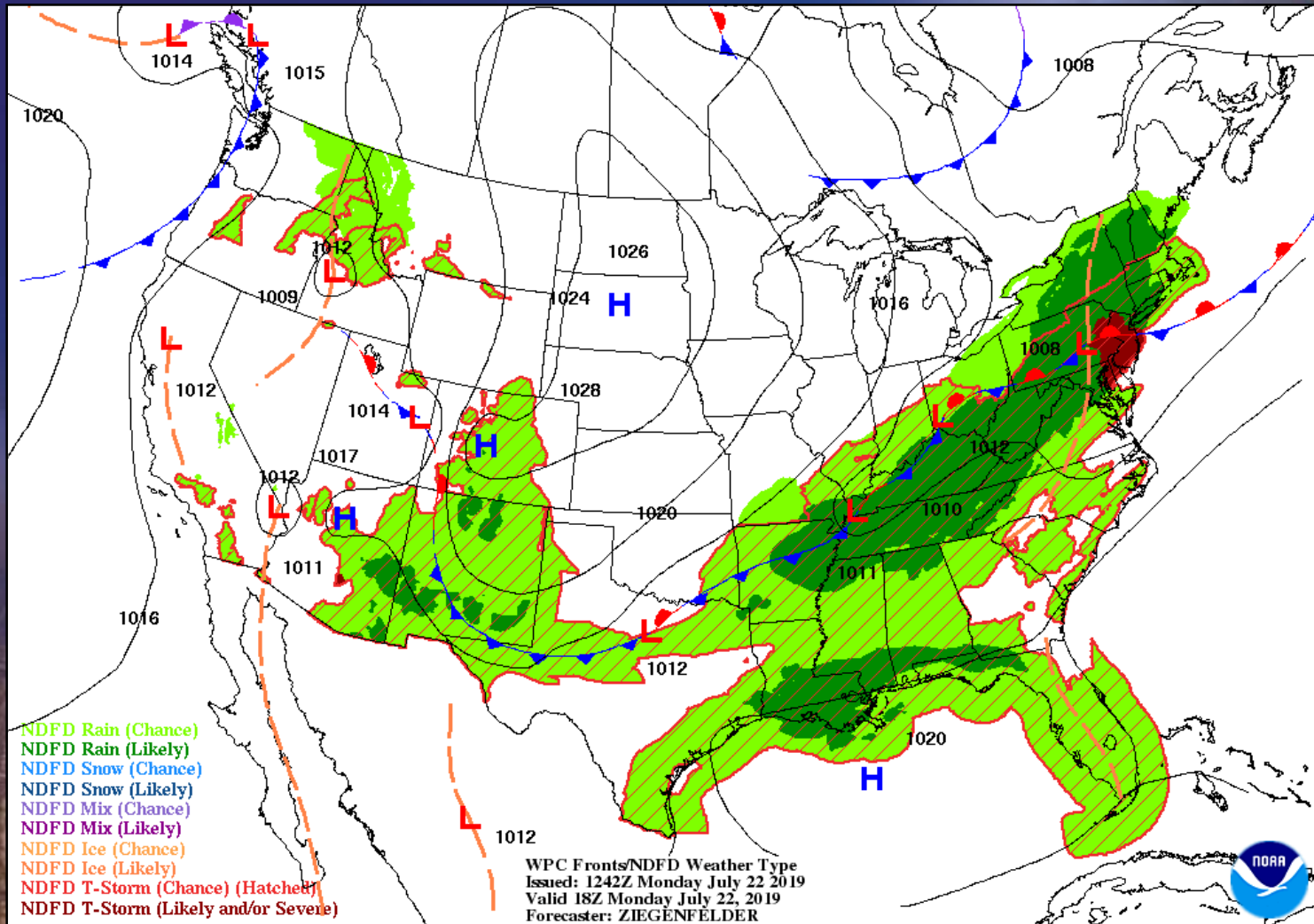

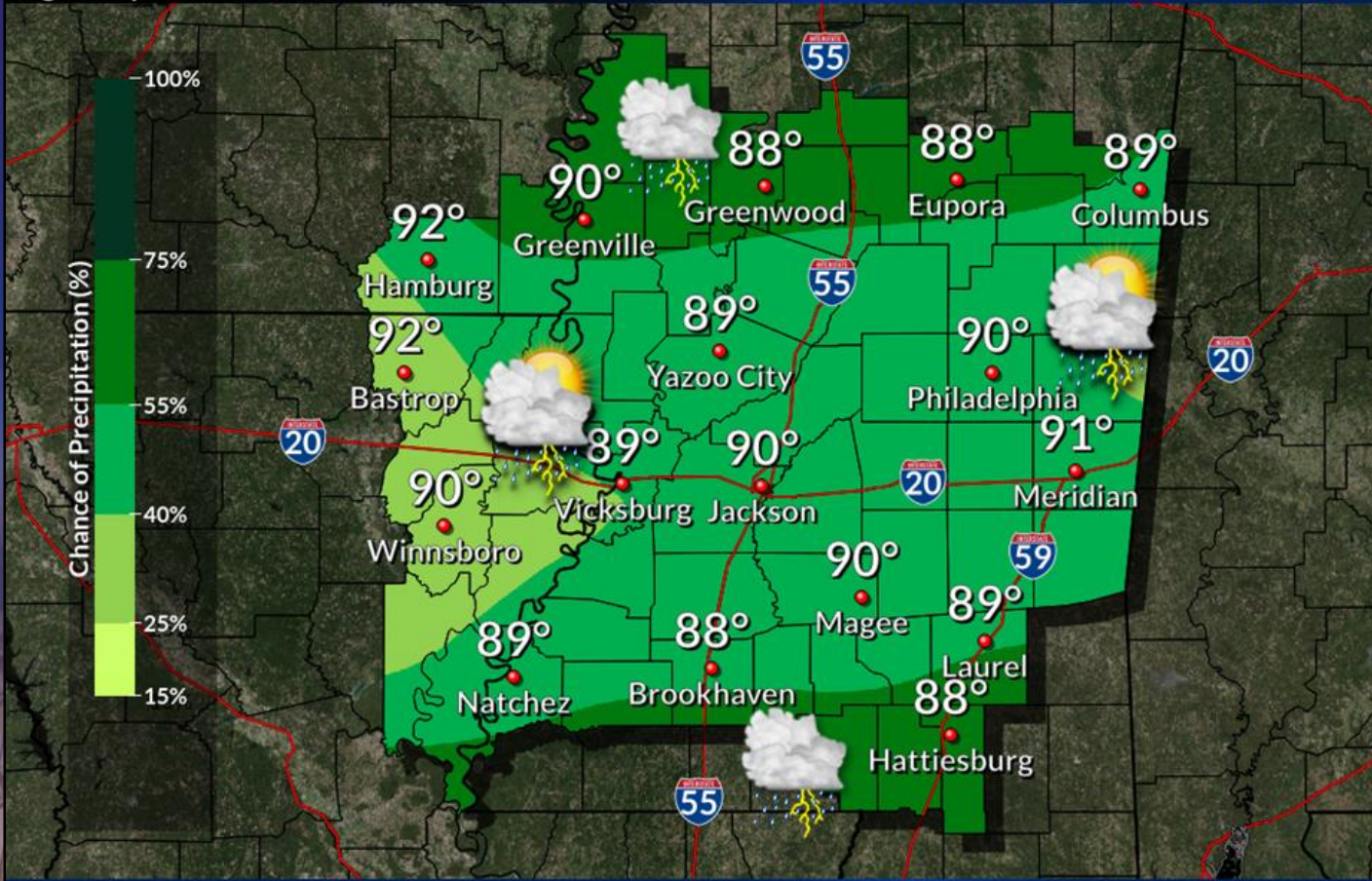

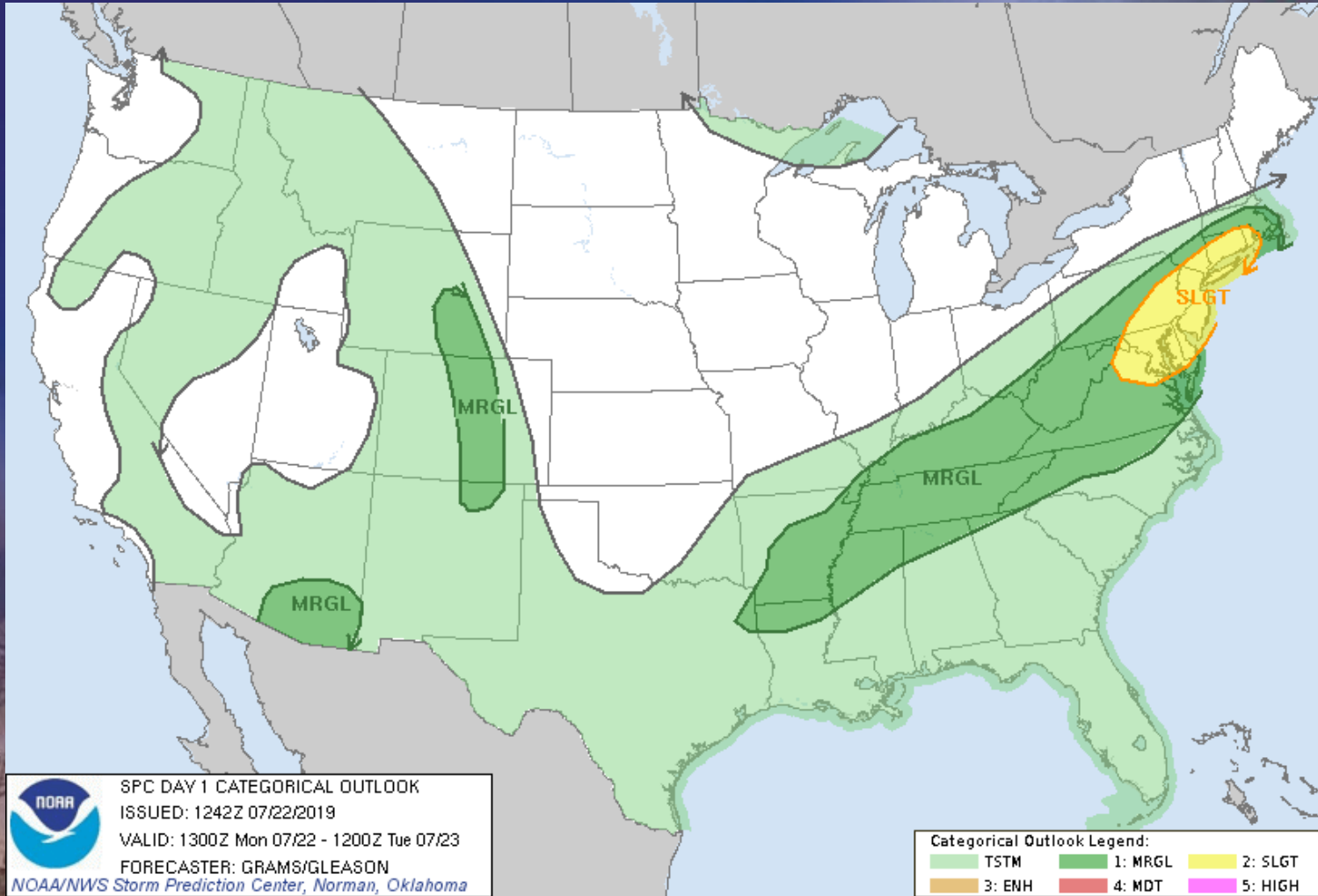

Storm Prediction Center Day 1 Severe Weather Outlook

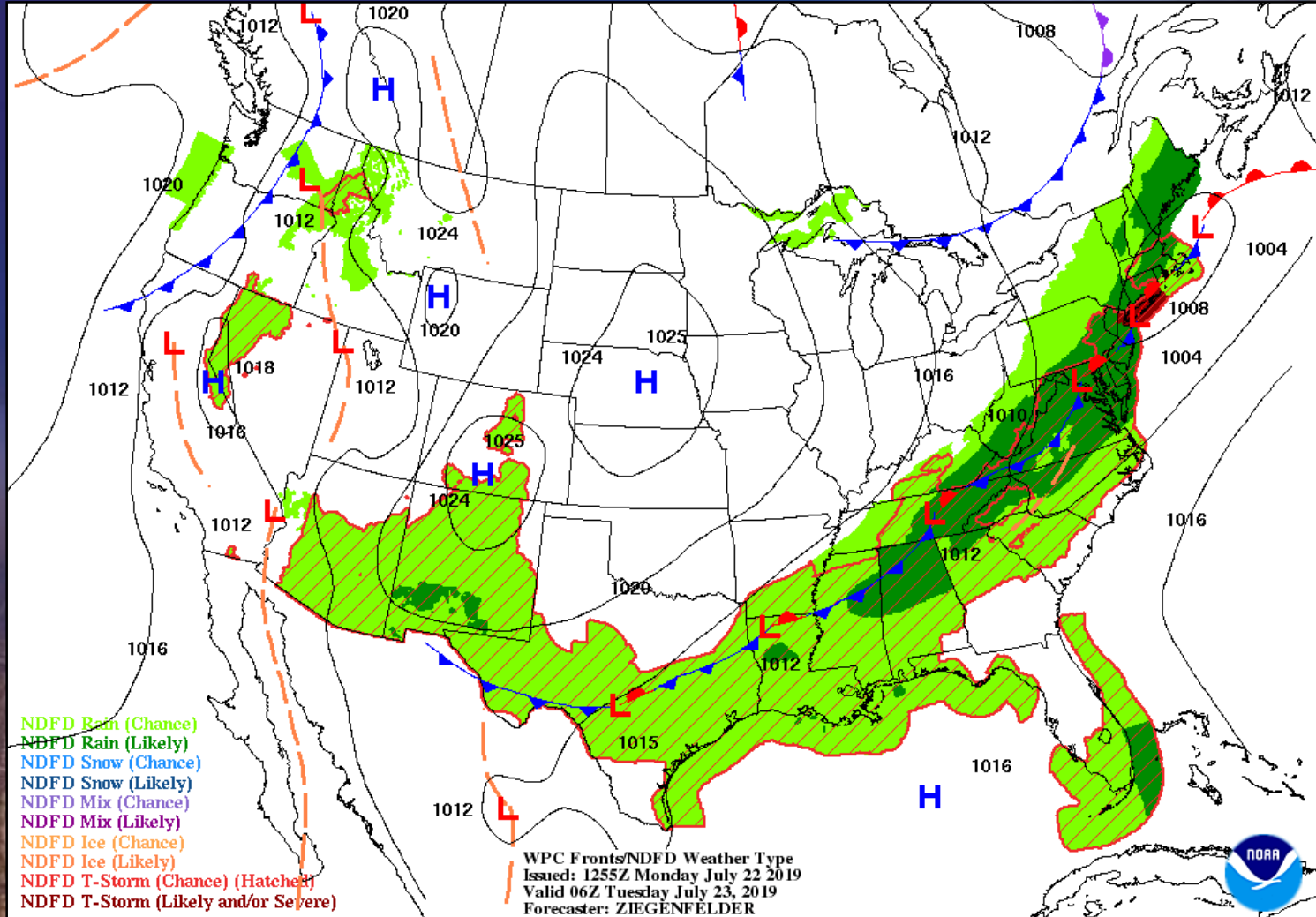


SPC Day 1 Outlook morning update extended the Marginal threat for severe storms across our northwest for today.

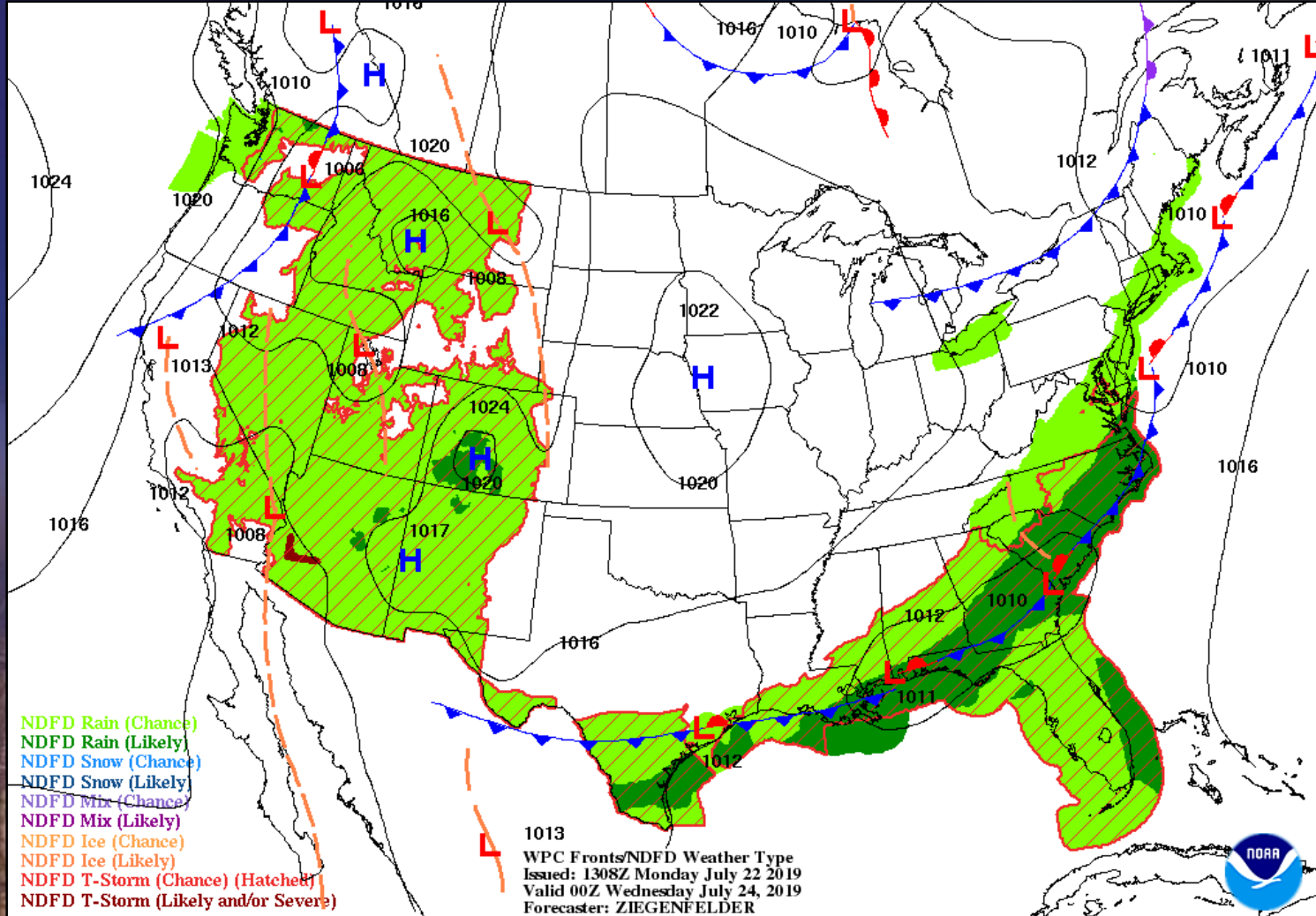

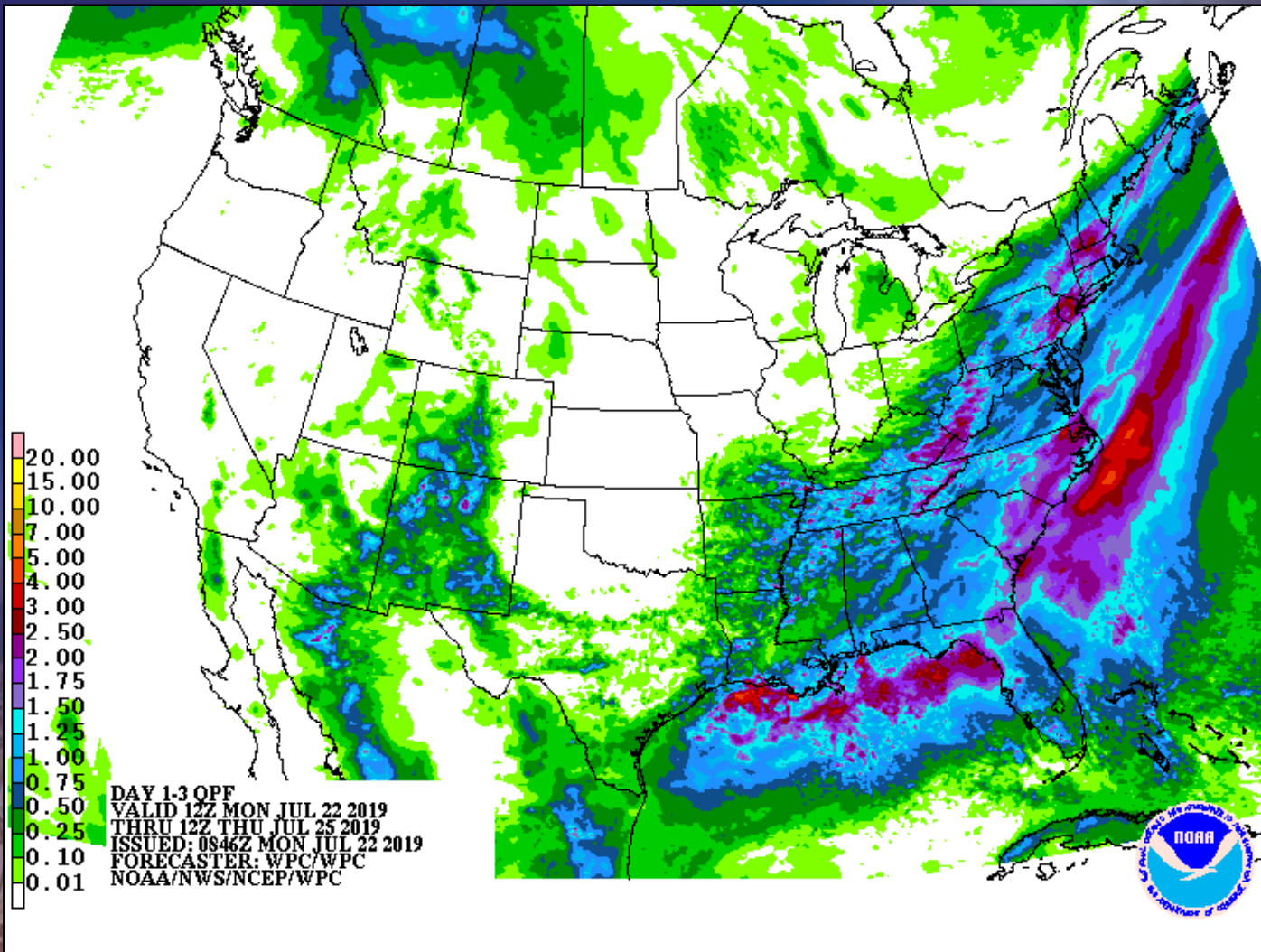

Days 1-3 Precipitation

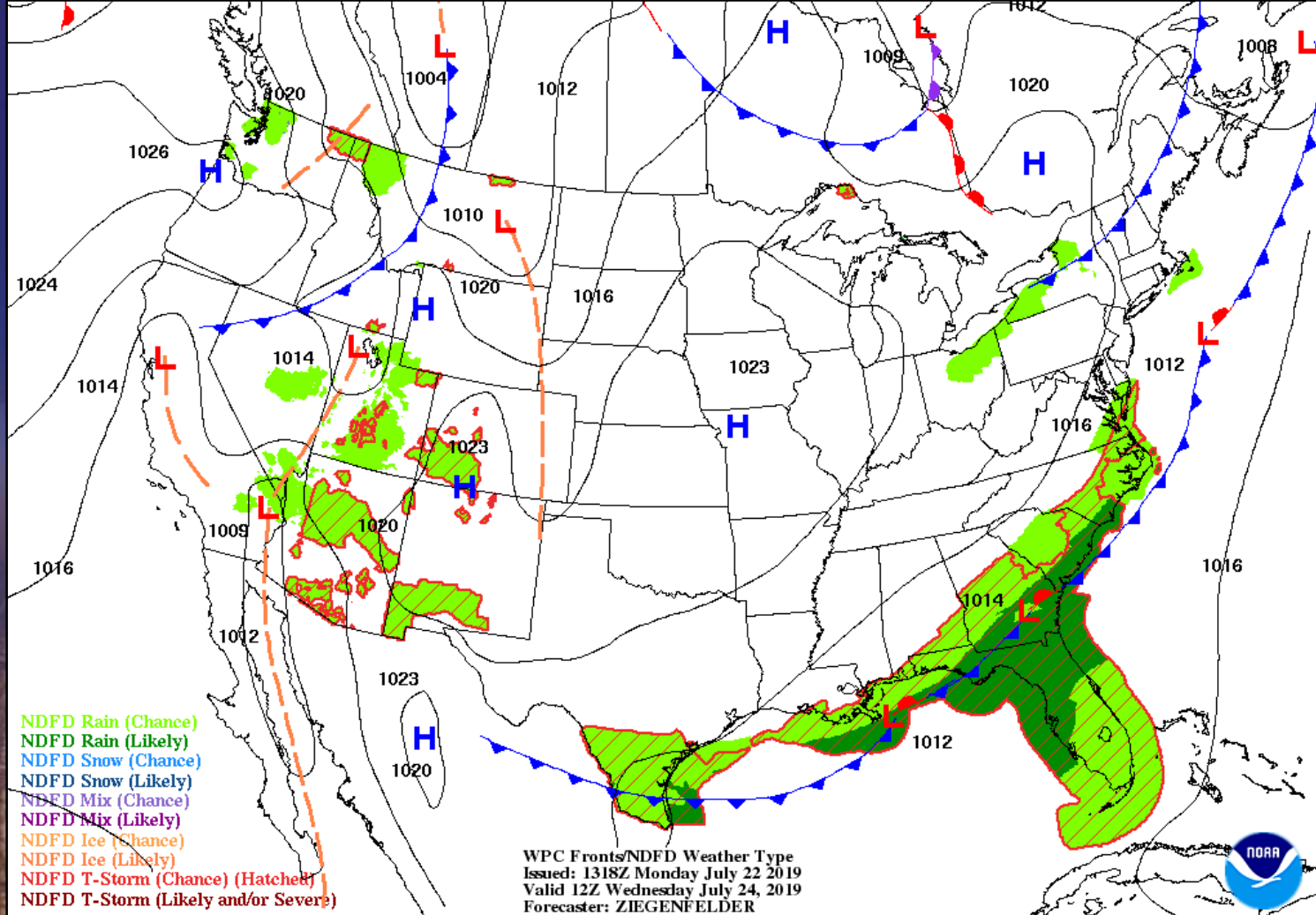


Some localized one to two inches will be possible with the rainfall today into Tuesday





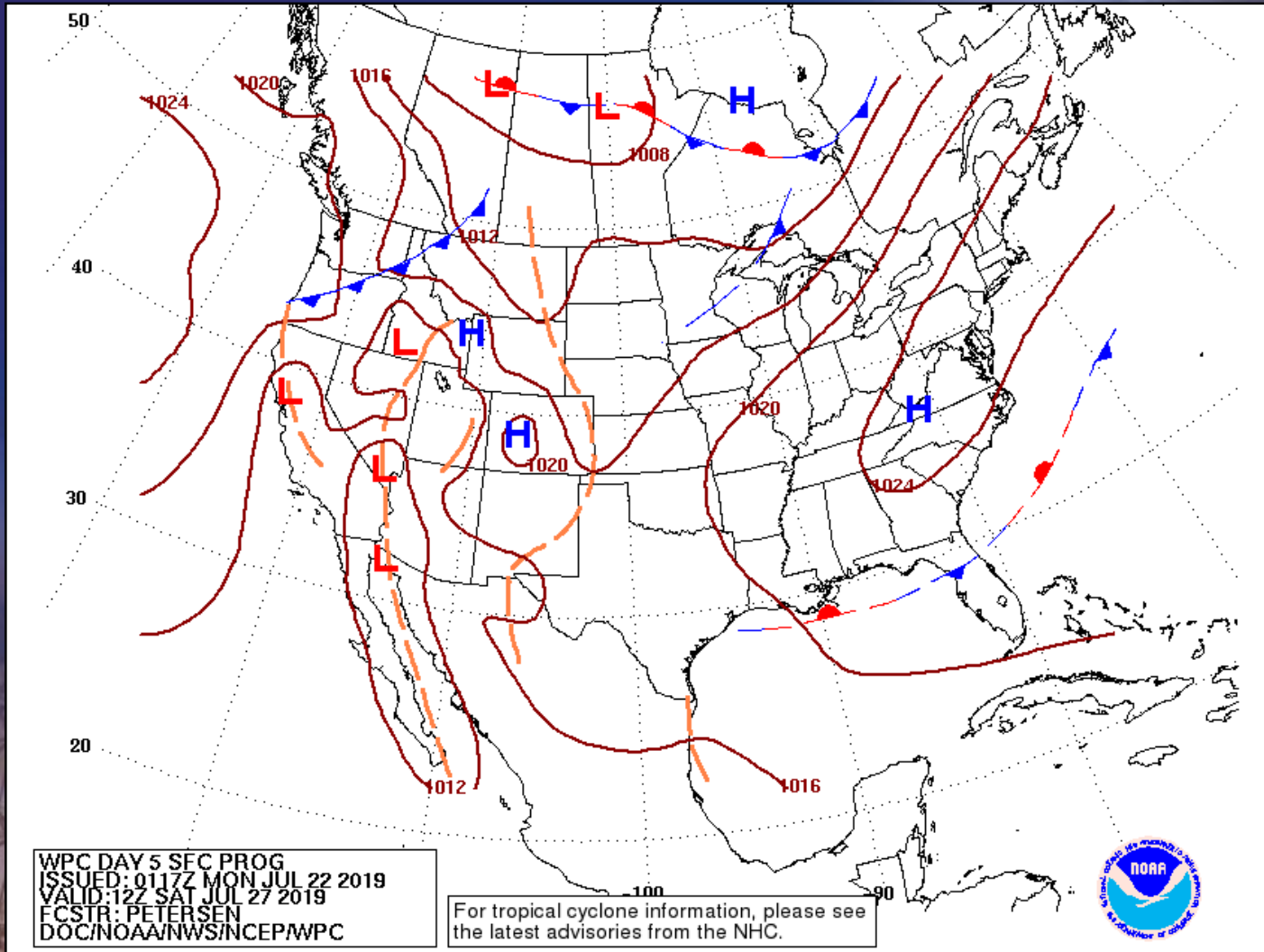
Wednesday-Thursday



Dry weather and cooler temperatures are expected Wednesday and Thursday as surface high pressure builds over the region from the north.



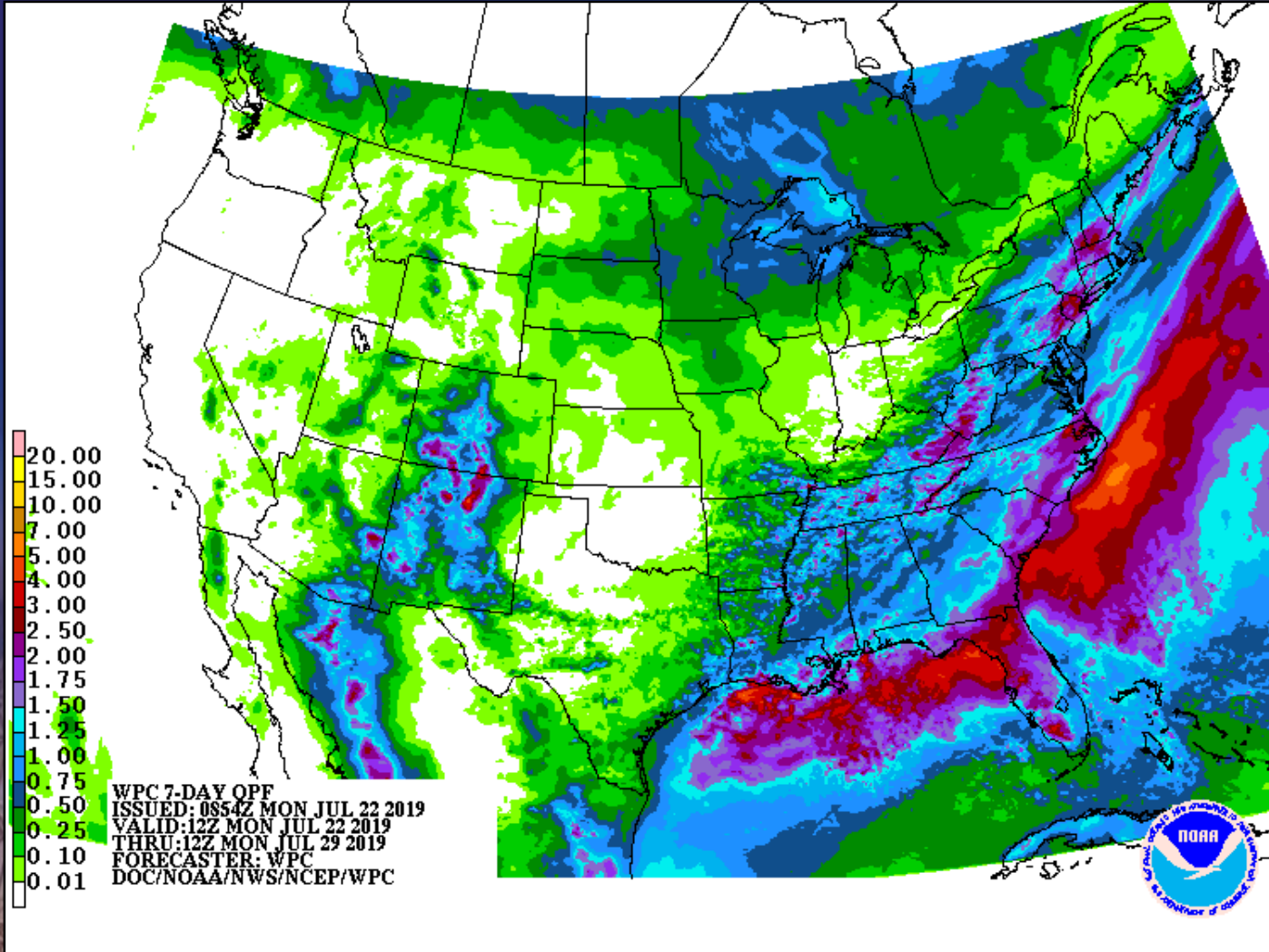
Friday – Weekend

7 Day Precipitation

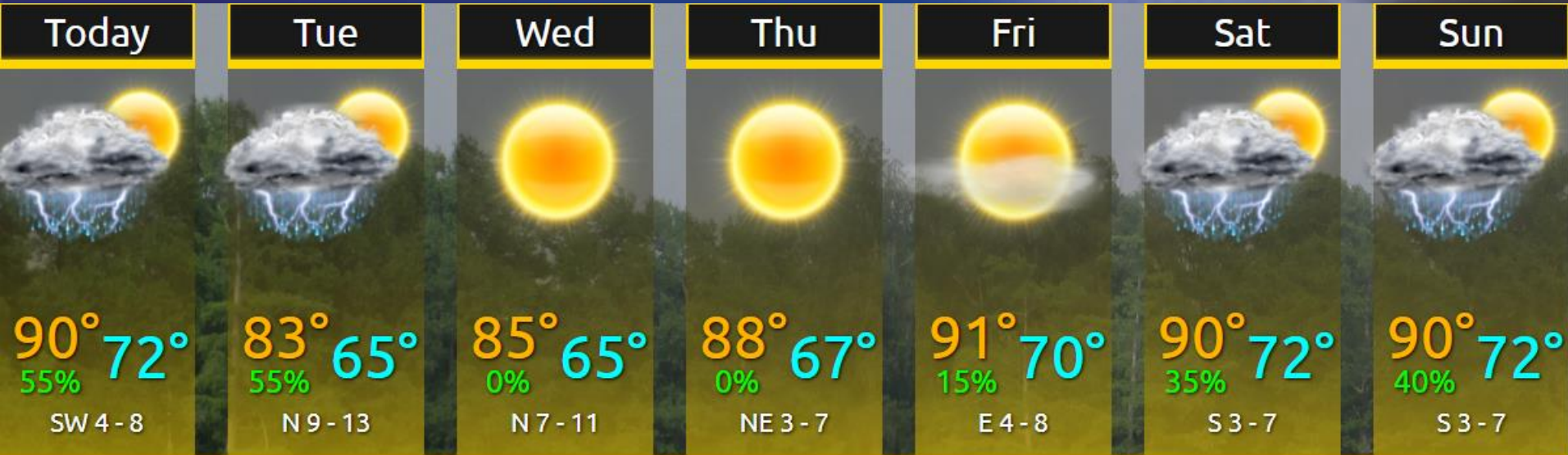


This week's rainfall amounts showing spotty one to two inch amounts over our area.

This week's forecast centered over Jackson, Mississippi.

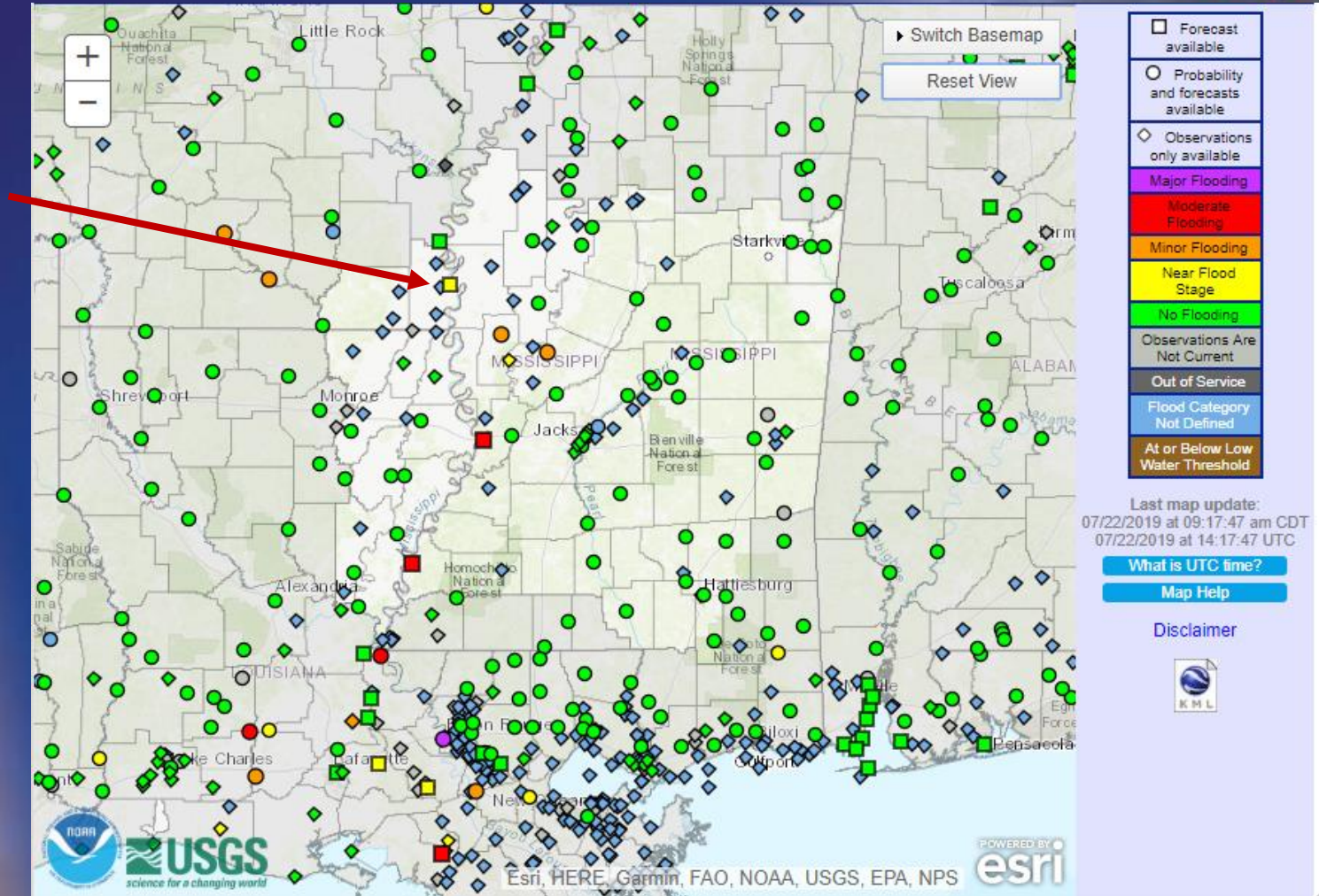




River Update



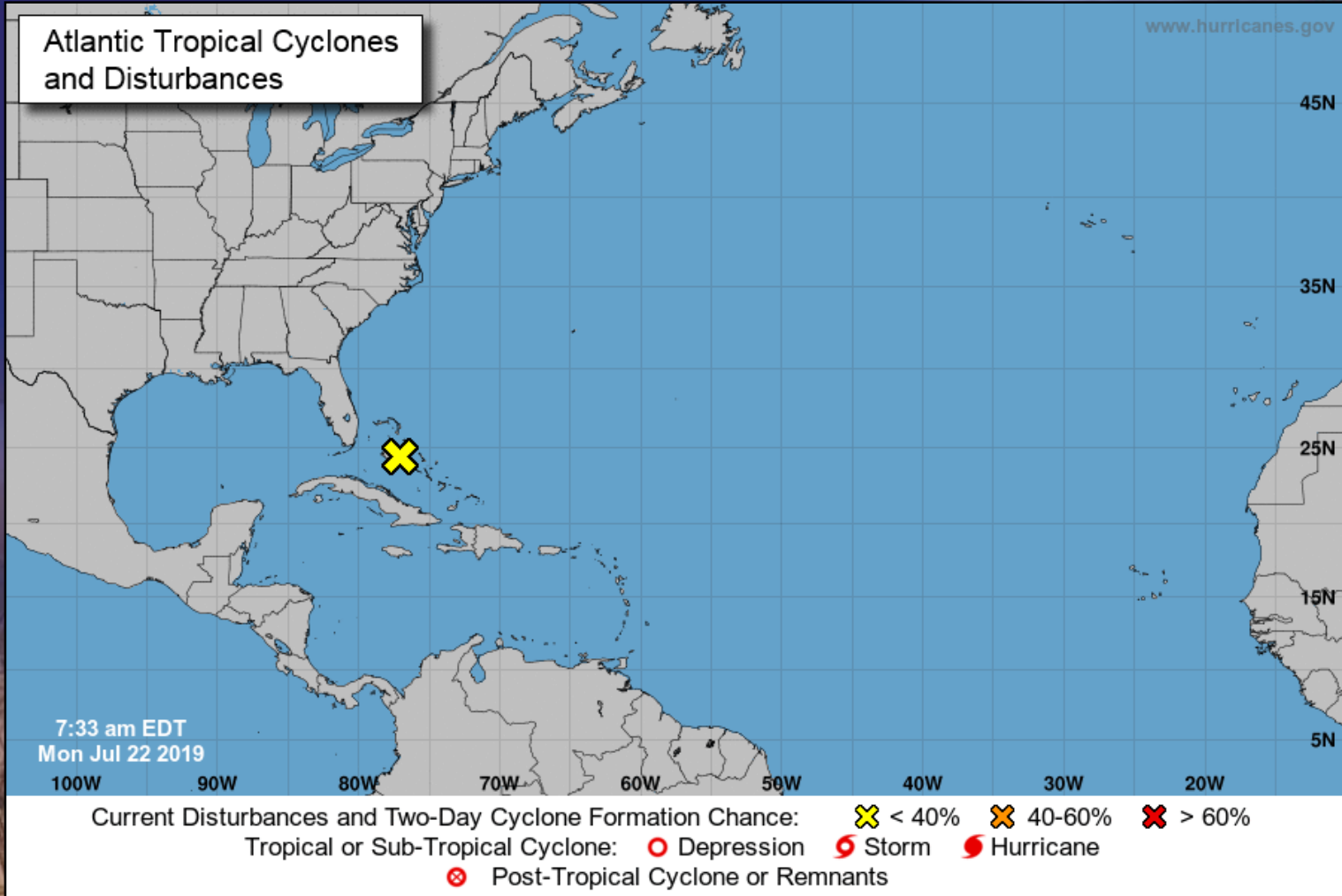
Greenville

National Hurricane Center Tropical Outlook Next 2 Days

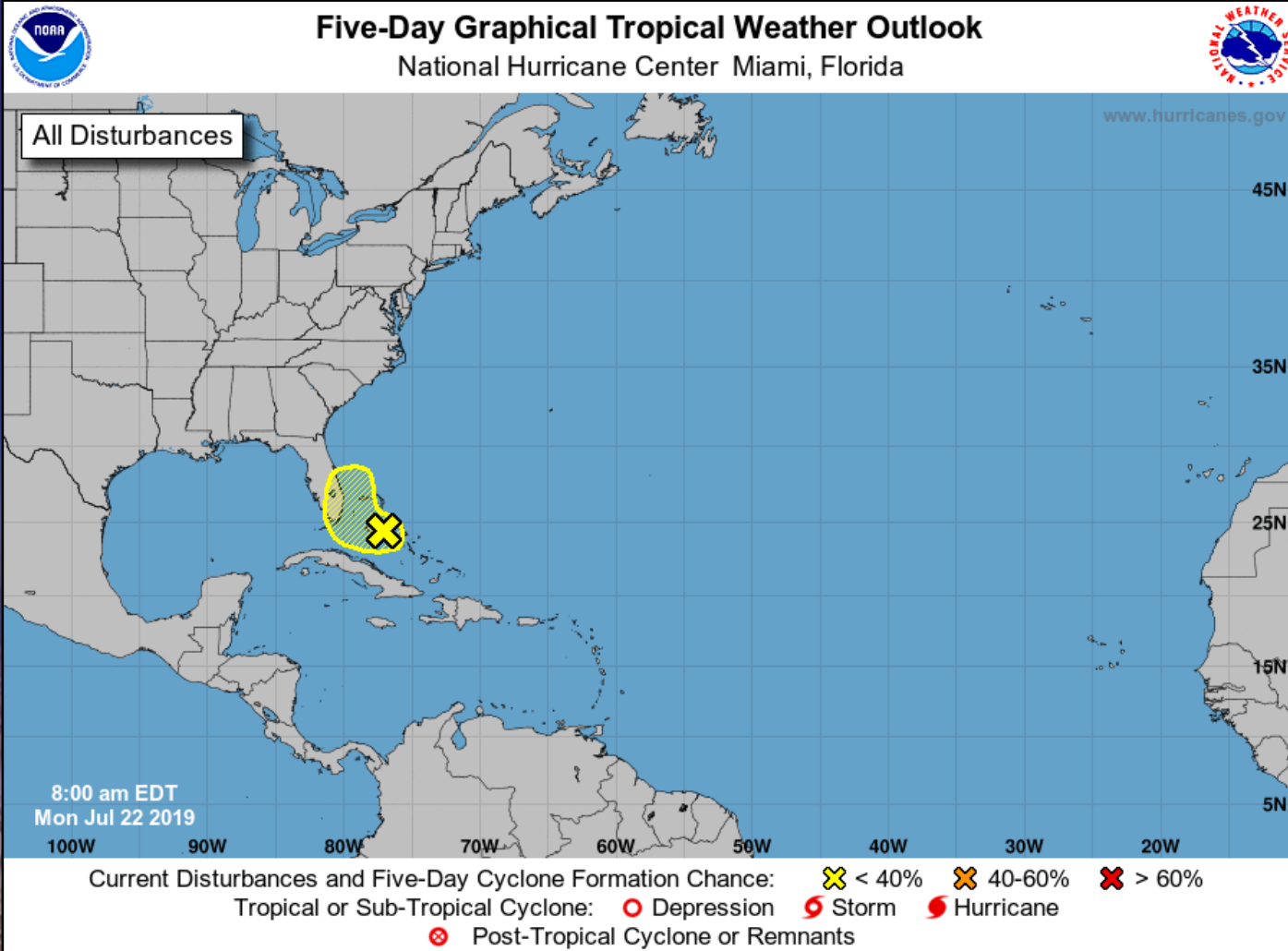


An area of showers and thunderstorms over the northwest Bahamas has a 30 percent chance of developing into a tropical cyclone within the next 2 days.
