



Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms are expected over the entire area toda, Highs will top out in the upper 80s to near 90.




Storm Prediction Center Day 1 Severe Weather Outlook







Showers and thunderstorms will linger overnight ahead of a cold front. Low temperatures will near normal in the lower 70s.




Tuesday



Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms will diminish from the northwest Tuesday as the cold front moves south through the region. Cooler than normal temperatures are expected.




Days 1-3 Precipitation






Wednesday-Thursday



Dry weather and cooler temperatures are expected Wednesday and Thursday as surface high pressure builds over the region from the north.







National Hurricane Center Tropical Outlook Next 2 Days






An area of showers and thunderstorms over the northwest Bahamas has a 30 percent chance of developing into a tropical cyclone within the next 2 days.
